3. It may be noted that only students who graduate during the validity period of accreditation, will be deemed to have graduated with an NBA accredited degree.

4. The programmes have been granted Provisional Accreditation for 2 years. As such, Beant College of Engineering & Technology, Post Box 13, Gurdaspur-143 521, Punjab is required to submit the Compliance report after 18 months. It may require submission of pre-qualifier before sending the Compliance report for granting further Accreditation. The process for submitting Pre-Qualifiers and Compliance report has been notified on the website of National Board of Accreditation.

5. The accreditation status awarded to the programmes as indicated in the above table does not imply that the accreditation has been granted to Beant College of Engineering & Technology, Post Box 13, Gurdaspur-143 521, Punjab as a whole. **As such the Institution should nowhere along with its name including on its letter head etc. write that it is accredited by NBA because it is programme accreditation and not Institution accreditation. If such an instance comes to NBA's notice, this will be viewed seriously.** Complete name of the programme(s) accredited, level of programmes and the period of validity of accreditation, as well as the date from which the accreditation is effective should be mentioned unambiguously whenever and wherever it is required to indicate the status of accreditation by NBA.


